GS pointed out that Science praised and the work that the staff have done since the last Ofsted has been recognised

MB explained that Ofsted were very clear that NEPS did not need a transition period in terms of the curriculum

SF thanked MB and MBe for all their hard work leading the staff through the process and for the extensive curriculum work

MB and MBe presented the progress data-for the whole school:

- **EYFS**-coming into school with very low baselines compared to pre covid
- Sampled areas PPG outperforming children in some areas
- A great deal of interventions being run by SLT, teachers and support staff using the school led tutoring grant
- Number 100% making progress in the EYFS

### **KS1 and KS2**

Progress from the October baseline to mid-February most children are making 1 point of progress at least

Year 1 high percentages –early reading PPG in line if not better-complexity of needs in the year group –multiple barriers –interventions being provide, there is a wide range – use of the tuition funding and are well attended.

1.4-point score across those groups etc. Used the data in PP meetings and the groups are being adjusted Spring 2-this will continue for as long as we receive the additional funding

Year 2 –Really strong progress-very challenging year group-missed a critical number of milestones. Did well in the phonics in Dec and those who did not pass are having several interventions and working with KS1 phase leader.

KS2 data similar picture-children in vulnerable groups writing FSM/SEN/PPG doing well helped by thinking skills and SLT mentoring programme has an impact

Wide range of interventions running all the time and are being closely monitored

Year 4 example in reading-3 children started an after-school comprehension progression is showing a third of the group making accelerated progression

Year 5 –writing boosters impact discussed and writing moderation has helped- attainment is low

Year 6 -11 children just under the point of progress –complexity of need –extra groups are in place and adjusted-these groups are being closely always monitored.

Attainment is low for the Year 6 but is being closely monitored and groups/teaching adjusted accordingly.

IS commented that the progress data and curriculum updates –presented clearly and was very helpful for the committee
