Curriculum Update The Curriculum Report was pre-circulated. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Curriculum Focus<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Sequentially plans are being regularly monitored.○ There is a good toolkit for Retrieval practice and more CPD is planned for Autumn 1.○ Children can articulate their substantive knowledge.• Assessment and Monitoring<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Year 2 and year 6 SATs went smoothly.○ Following the recent monitoring visit there were NO recommendations.○ 24% of Year 4 children achieved 1005 in the Multiplication Table Check.○ There will be more CPD in September.• Reception Data<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Children started with a low starting point in September. | |

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Whilst children do come in lower they make incredible progress. ○ A lot of children were EAL. ○ Many children had not attended another setting. ○ There are lots of issues in the background. ○ NELI = Nuffield Early Learning Intervention. ○ GS asked how the targets are set. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Based on the expected level of progress ▪ 3 steps of progress is equal. ▪ The target is calculated by SIMS. ○ GS also asked about the Baseline Test. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ This is a standard test across the country which was introduced in 2021. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This had been delayed due to Covid. ▪ The test takes 20 minutes per child. ▪ Historically we always did our own baseline which was more detailed / harder to do. ● Year 1 Data <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ We have seen 10 mid-year joiners. ○ These children had multiple barriers including FSM / EAL. ○ One child joined from a Special School abroad. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ They should really be in a Special School rather than North Ealing, and it will probably be at least another year before there is a place. ○ Phonics data will be included in the Headteacher’s Report. ● Year 2 Data <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ This has been a challenging cohort. ○ We are looking to move some of these children to an ERSA > EHCP. ○ Attainment is lower than pre-pandemic. ○ GS asked if it was common for boys to be ahead of girls. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ No. ▪ Cohort specific. ● Year 3 Data <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Writing suffered more during the pandemic as it is hard to teach writing online. ● Year 6 Data <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ We aim to be back to pre-pandemic levels by next year. ○ There have been lots of interventions for Year 6 in preparation for SATs / high School. ○ DL said that he would be interested to know about the impact of the new maths scheme (Power Maths) on SATs – <u>Autumn Term meeting.</u> ● Oracy Project <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ We have made a successful bid with other Ealing Schools and inked up with Voice 21, the National Oracy Education Charity. ○ This will start in September. ○ We will have 2 Oracy Leaders plus SF and MBr. | Agenda |
